

SUPPLY LIST FOR "MONO PRINTING ON A GELL PLATE"

- 1) Gelli Arts Printing Plate – I use 8" x 10" size. [Www.gelliarts.com](http://www.gelliarts.com). Gelliarts also has a 9" x 12" if you wish to go larger.
- 2) Speedball Soft Rubber Brayer (4")
- 3) Alcohol Inks – Marabu, Ranger. Just bring a few colors. I will bring some to share with you.
- 4) Printing Paper – Many kinds of paper will work. Strathmore Bristol, Mixed media (comes in a notebook) work fine. Card stock or BFK Rives (white size 22 x 30. You can cut 7-8 pieces of 8x10 off one sheet. Also book, music, map pages and newsprint paper works well.
- 5) Paints – Acrylic paints. Fluid Acrylics, Golden Open, Americana, Folk Art, etc. Bring a variety of colors. Also bring some gel medium and iridescent paints if you have them.
- 6) Water bucket, paper towels, spray bottle, pallet knife, scissors, baby wipes to clean your gell plate. I do not use hand sanitizer to clean my plate. I do not recommend it.
- 7) Bring mark making tools, combs, stencils (both small and large) , embossed papers, a sponge, cheesecloth, bubble wrap, waxed paper, or saran wrap, feathers, or any items that will add texture. Also go outside and pick up leaves or other natural items you think will add interest to your prints. Make sure your leaves have texture on the back side. I will also bring the above items to share with you.

Bring a roll of scotch tape.
