My current art supply list: this is only a guidance list your current supplies will suffice.

- 1. Arches 9" X 12" cold press 300 lb. white color block.
- 2. 9" X 12" sketch book.
- 3. I prefer to use HB pencils when drafting a painting. It keeps a sharp point for a long time, and easy to erase. For sketching on location, and notes I use a black ebony pencil.
- 4. A small water hand pump spray water bottle.
- Grumbacher Miskit liquid frisket, best for laying down because of its pink color. Liquid soap to mix with water, so that miskit will not build up on brushes. I also have brushes that I use exclusively to lay down miski/friskit.
- 6. Sizing liquid, used to reduce the absorbency of paper.
- 7. Windsor and Newton watercolor blending medium.
- 8. 15" X 101/2" White enamel butchers tray.
- 9. Winsor and Newton watercolors.
- 10. Brushes- Grumbacher and Windsor and Newton red sable, numbers 1-7, number 10, round and ½", 1", 2" flat.
- 11. Paper 300 lb Arches rough surface cold press.
- 12. Assortment of sponges, paper towels, and a small, sharp pocket knife for picking up highlights.
- 13. Paint eraser, this a wonderful product.
