Watercolor paint in tubes ---- basic set of 6 – 12.

Bring what you have.

If you want to purchase some individually, I suggest:

Yellows—lemon, Aurelian yellow

Blues: Ultramarine blue, cobalt blue, Antwerp blue

Reds: Alizarin, and a medium red. Scarlet lake is a good one

Greens: Hookers green, Sap green, Windsor green

Raw umber, burnt umber or sepia

Palette for watercolor, preferably one with a lid

Water container 1 pint -- 1 quart

Watercolor paper—1 sheet 22 x 30 inches Arches 140# cold press.

(We will cut the paper into 4 sections, enough for the 4 classes)

Watercolor support board= thick foam core or a drawing board. May be borrowed from art room for class.

Watercolor brushes: Size # 6 and # 8 round and a 1-2 inch flat. Synthetic is fine

Fine mist spray bottle—small

Facial tissues, paper towels, pencils, eraser, old towel, old toothbrush.
