- A PALETTE TO PUT YOUR PAINT ON & Mix PAINT
- A SMALL SPRAY WATER BOTTLE 'BLUE PAINTERS TAPE
- KNEADED ERASER & SKETCH PAD
- DRAWING PENCIL, 28 OR 4H
- 2 WATER CONTAINERS FOR CLEANING YOUR BRUSHES
- LARGE REGULAR SPONGE
- PAPER TOWELS
- #8 or #10 ROUND WATERCOLOR BRUSH. 1" OR 2" FLAT
 BRUSH FOR WASHES. (i RECOMMEND THE LOEW CORNELL
 7020 ULTRA ROUND BRUSHES. THEY LAST LONG. ARE COMPARABLY INEXPENSIVE AND HAVE A
